Leader: Can anyone perfectly keep the commandments of God?

People: Since the fall, no ordinary person can perfectly keep the commandments of God in this life but breaks them every day in thought, word, and action.

Leader: Are all sins equally evil?

People: In the eyes of God some sins in themselves are more evil than others, and some are more evil because of the harm that results from them.
