It was on October 31, 1517 that Martin Luther posted his ninety-five theses on the church door in Wittenberg, Germany, the watershed event sparking the Reformation. Reformation Day is also a day when we remember and give thanks for Reformation leaders and all others who have kept the faith.

FROM THE WESTMINSTER PULPIT

The 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the beginning of the Protestant Reformation is this month! In a 5-week sermon series, we’ll learn about the five mottoes or solas (in Latin) that capture the core of Reformed theology.

Oct. 8 Sola Scriptura (“Scripture alone”):  
The Bible alone is our highest authority.

Oct. 15 Solus Christus (“Christ alone”):  
Jesus Christ alone is our Lord, Savior, and King.

Oct. 22 Sola Gratia (“grace alone”):  
We are saved by the grace of God alone.

Today Sola Fide (“faith alone”):  
We are saved through faith alone in Jesus Christ.

Nov. 5 Soli Deo Gloria (“to the glory of God alone”):  
We live for the glory of God alone.
