- We are delighted that you have joined us for in-person or online worship, and we hope you are encouraged and strengthened in the faith.
- A nursery is available for children 2 and under in the Preschool Building. We'll gather pertinent information upon check-in and be able to contact you during the service should a need arise.
- Parents who need to step out of the sanctuary for a while to tend to the needs of infants or small children can find privacy down the hall in the church parlor, family restroom, or in the church nursery.
- Worship bags and worship worksheets are available in the narthex for preschool and elementary age children.
- Following Time for Children (11:00 only) children ages 3-5k will gather in the narthex with Mrs. Janie and then be led to the playground (weather permitting) or Covenant Hall for Children's Church with adult leaders. Parents may pick them up there following the service.
- Hearing devices, magnifying sheets, and large print hymnals are available in the narthex.

COVID PROTOCOLS FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP

*Thank you for following these protocols
which enable weekly in-person worship without interruption.*

1. Hand sanitizer will be available and should be used upon entering.
2. Everyone is required to wear a mask upon entering and for the duration of the service.
3. Seating is socially distanced starting at the front of the sanctuary. Please allow ushers to seat you and your family.
4. During time for children, the children will remain with their family and not gather on the chancel steps. Following time for children at 11:00, adult leaders will lead children ages 3-5k to the Playground (weather permitting) or Covenant Hall for Children's Church. Parents may pick them up there following the service.
5. At the end of the service, the ushers will dismiss the congregation by row from the side aisles, beginning at the rear of the sanctuary.
6. Offering plates will be at the entrances/exits to receive your offering.

 3. On a Sunday morning, you'll attend a meeting with the Session for reception into membership. We'll handle paperwork if you're transferring from another church or arrange baptism if you've never been baptized.
 4. That same Sunday morning, you'll be introduced to the congregation during worship.
