### LETTER FROM BIRMINGHAM JAIL

Martin Luther King, Jr. wrote this letter from jail in 1963 in response to a group of moderate clergy urging him to 'wait,' have patience, and trust the system to bring about change. His letter still has meaning today: *"We know through painful experience that freedom is never voluntarily given by the oppressor; it must be demanded by the oppressed. Frankly, I have never yet engaged in a direct-action movement that was 'well timed' according to the timetable of those who have not suffered unduly from the disease of segregation. For years now I have heard the word 'wait.' It rings in the ear of every Negro with a piercing familiarity. This 'wait' has almost always meant 'never.'"*

## FROM THE WESTMINSTER PULPIT

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the most important event in the history of the world. In the resurrection of Jesus, death is undone and the curse is broken. It is why the message of the earliest Christians was focused on the resurrection. They did not risk their lives to proclaim a gospel of "be nice like Jesus." They risked their lives to declare the resurrection: Jesus is victorious over death, and the ones who are in him share in that victory. We have, as the apostle says, been made alive together with Christ. In the next weeks, we'll explore the four major relationships where we have been brought from Death to Life.
