## **GREETINGS**

#### From Pastor Daniel

Our Presbytery (Charleston Atlantic) has called a new General Presbyter and Pastor to Pastors. That's a mouthful. Here's what it means:

Our presbytery is a group of close to 50 churches from Hilton Head up to Orangeburg and over to McClellanville. We are a wonderful mixture of small and large churches, spanning a wide range geographically, politically, and racially. Our presbytery has a small staff, and the General Presbyter functions as both the Head of Staff and the Pastor to the pastors in our presbytery. Charleston Atlantic functions well together in mission (think Hands of Christ and campus ministry) and ministry (think our newest church in Charleston, Parkside).

I recently had the great privilege of co-chairing the Search Team to seek our new General Presbyter. We prayed and looked, finally feeling led to the one God called before us. Her name is Rev. Becky Albright, and since she has been part of the presbytery for many years, you may already know her. Here's some more information.

After a thorough search, including the development and posting of a Ministry Discernment Form in the PCUSA call system, consultation with our Synod Executive, advertising and recruitment through a national publication, interviews with candidates, and much prayer and discernment, we are of one mind and spirit in recommending Rev. Rebecca Albright to Charleston Atlantic Presbytery as the person God is calling to the position of General Presbyter and Pastor to Pastors.

Becky is a gifted and experienced Pastor, one we believe has been brought to the forefront for such a time as this. She brings years of experience as a small business owner and accountant, serving in the Presbyterian Church in countless ways. Her call to ministry, seminary experience, call to serve in the local church, and the call to serve as the presbytery's Bridge General Presbyter and Pastor to Pastors has prepared her for this moment. Her faith, reliance on the Spirit, commitment to the church, and vision for the future impressed the Search Committee and helped us discern her as the candidate God had provided.

God is good! Becky was installed, along with our new Stated Clerk, David Yandle, at the meeting of Presbytery on February 24. It was a day of celebration. We look forward to welcoming Becky for a visit to Westminster in the near future.



## **GIVE TO BACKPACK BUDDIES**

#### **HOW IT WORKS**

- The Lowcountry Food Bank first piloted the BackPack Buddies Program in 2006 to address the specific problem of weekend hunger among at risk children in the lowcountry.
- WPC picks up pallets of food from Lowcountry Food Bank on Wednesday
- Food is sorted and packed at Wonderful Wednesday Supper
- A typical weekend menu consists of a whole grain cereal, two single serving proteins, a cereal bar, a yogurt pouch, a vegetable and a fruit.
- WPC packs for 110 children at Goodwin Elementary School to receive food each weekend.
- In addition to those that we pack, WPC is also paying for the food for 140 children each week at Stono Park Elementary whose weekend meals are packed by St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church on Wappoo Road.

#### **NEED**

We need funding to provide these meals and our financial commitment to this program is losing some of its strength. We need donations of about \$25,000 each year to feed the children we are currently feeding.
